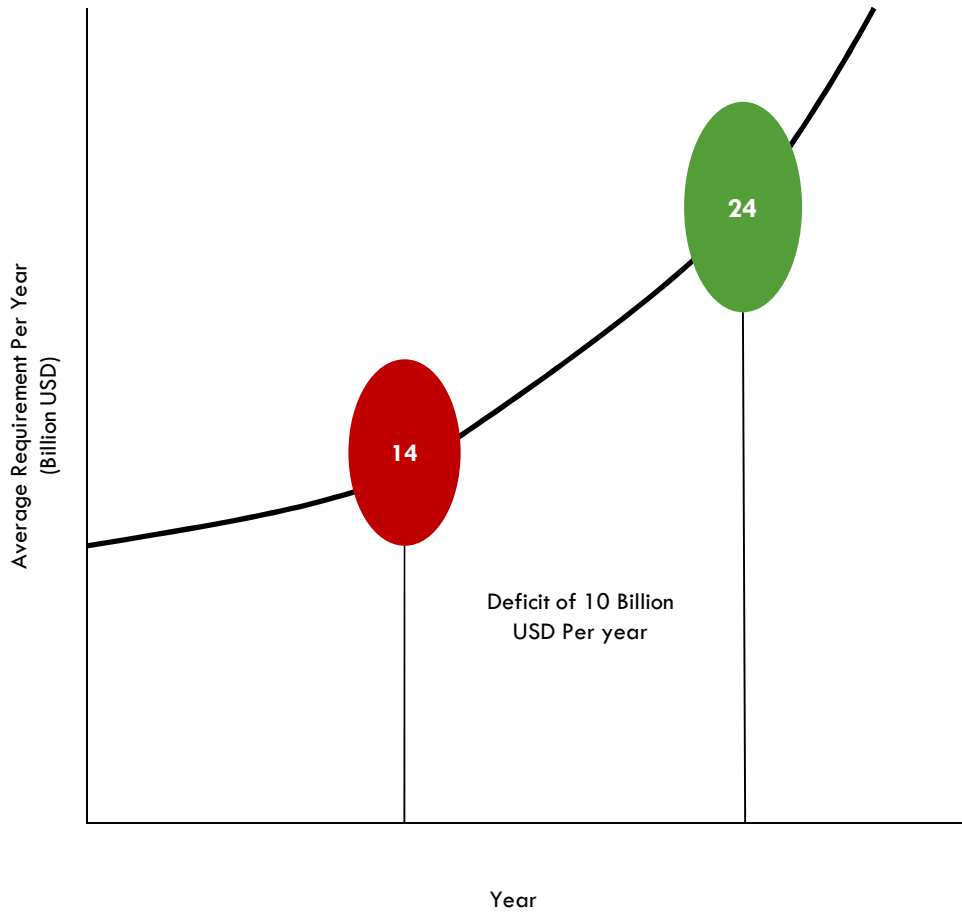

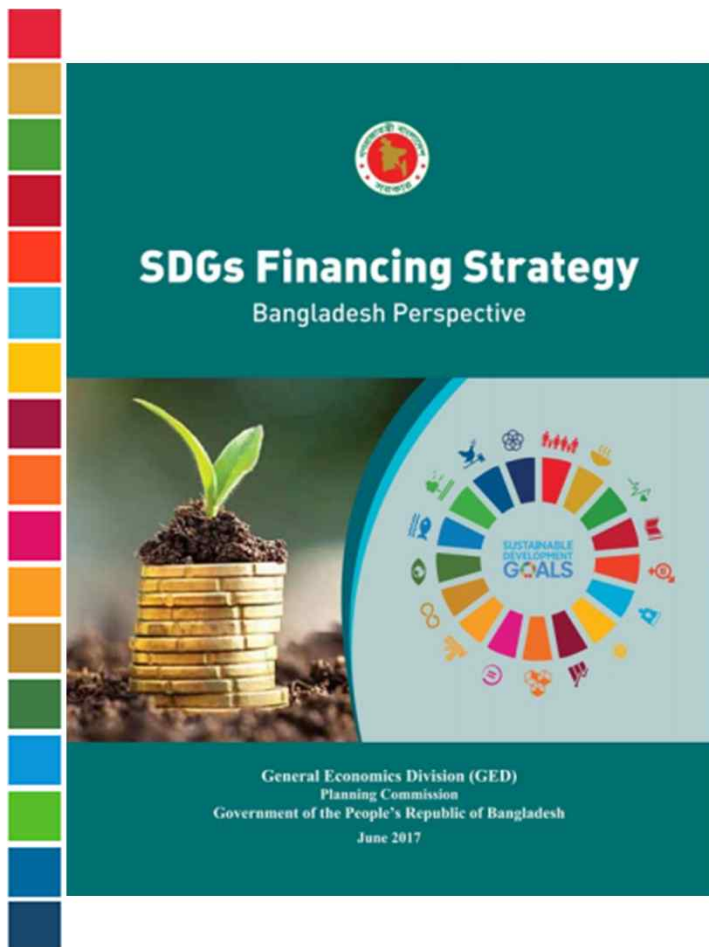
# Investment Need & Deficit

# SDG Financing Strategy

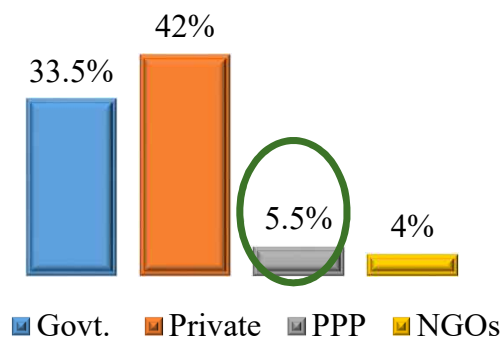


US\$ 928.48 Billion additional funding would be required from 2017 to 2030 for Bangladesh.

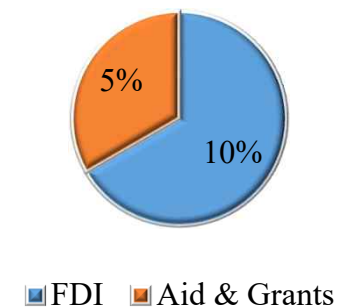
- Annual average cost: US\$ 66.32 billion

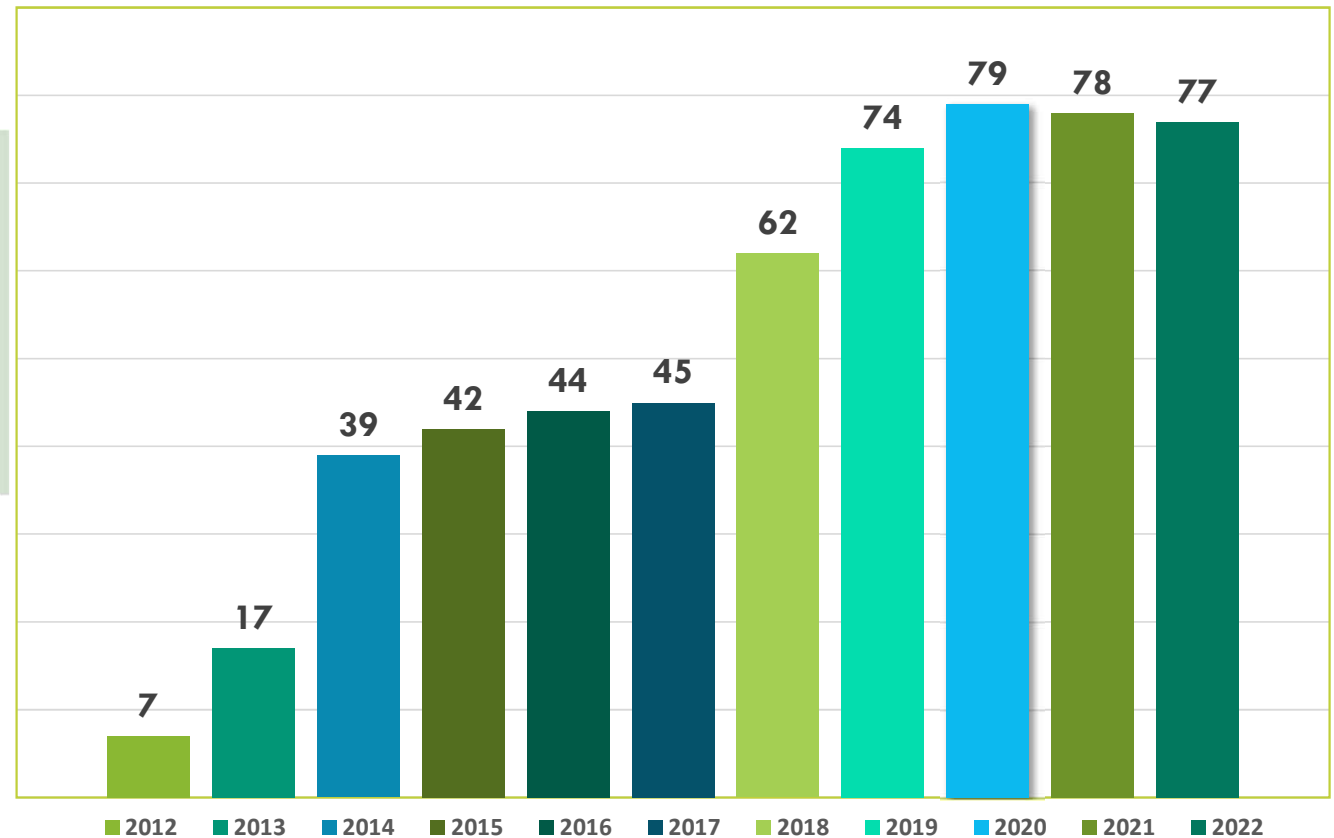

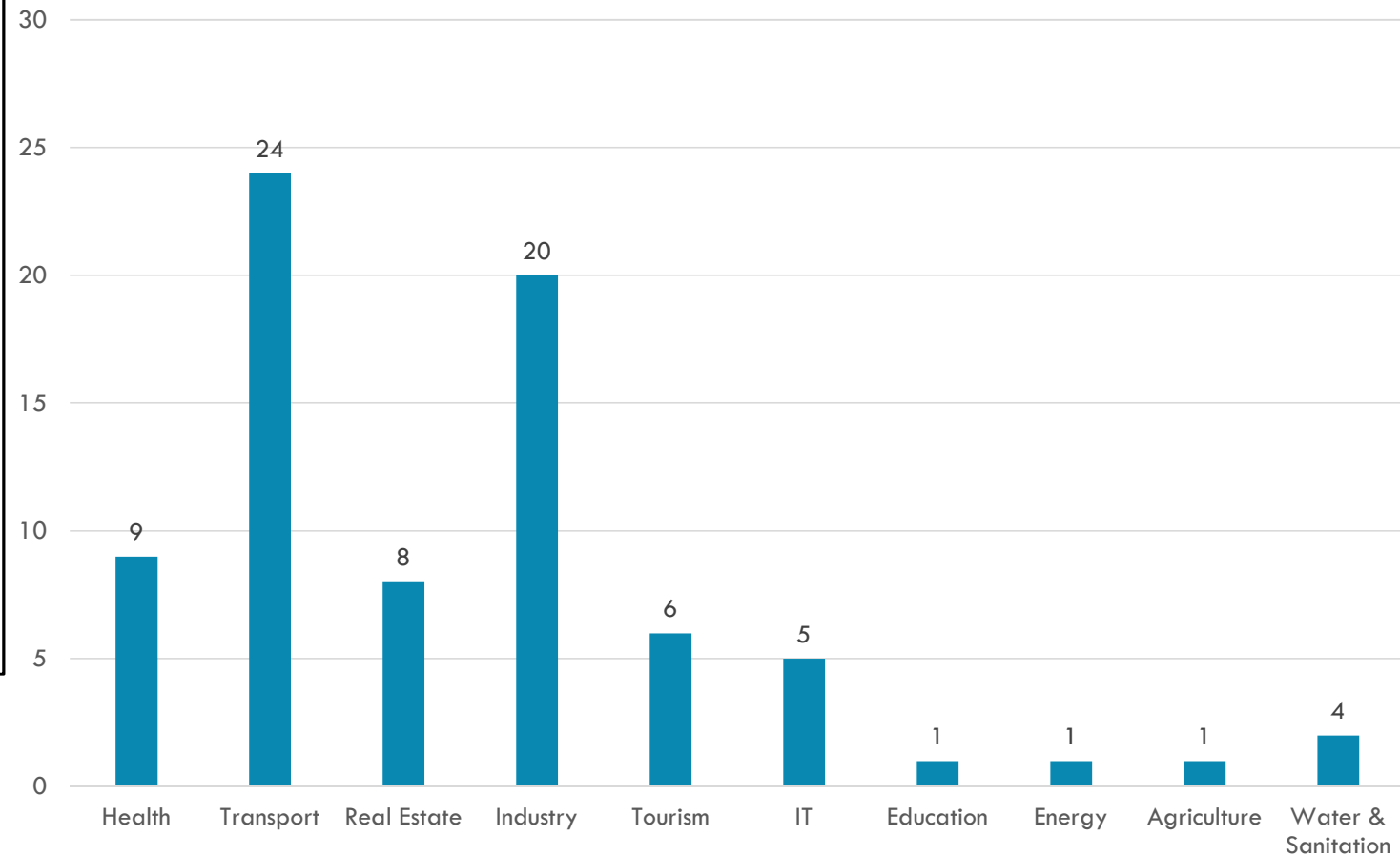
