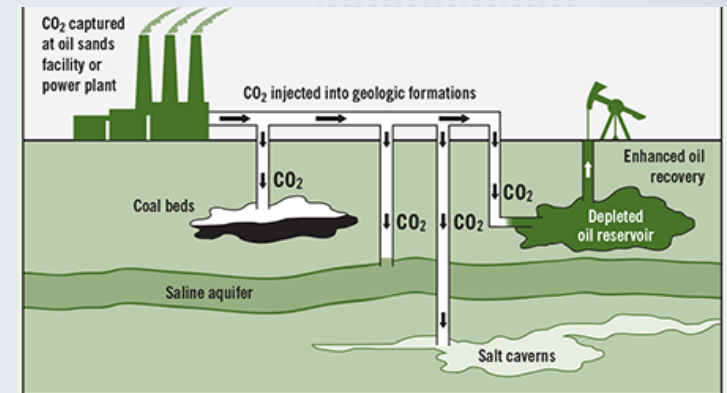

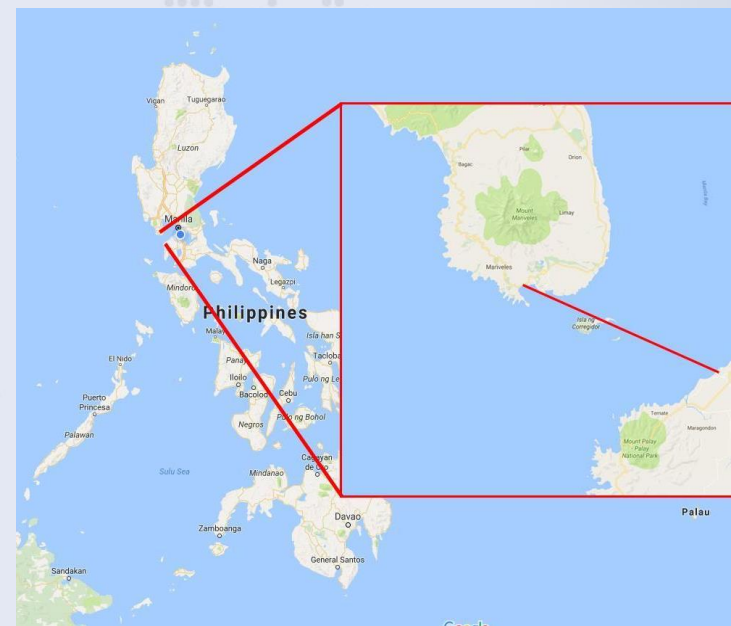


## Indonesia: Achieving MDG Education Goals

- ▶ Knowledge-Informed Policymaking
- ▶ 70+ policy briefs on priority issues
- ▶ Lessons:
  - Short, user-friendly content (vs. long research papers)
  - Government-led capacity development more effective

## Philippines: Infrastructure Preparation and Innovation Facility

- ▶ Access to best practices, knowledge, innovation, technology
- ▶ Sustained management support for sophisticated projects
- ▶ Accelerated processes (due diligence, detailed engineering designs, bidding)



# Knowledge Technical Assistance

## Myanmar – Transport Sector

- Nine reports on transport sector
- Range of high-impact policy reforms and initiatives
- Presented to incoming government April 2016
- Promoted policy dialogue and spearheaded projects



## Indonesia – Energy Sector

- Study on LED street lighting
- New energy-efficient technologies cut costs 60%
- Piloted and scaled up – expanded coverage in underserved areas.
